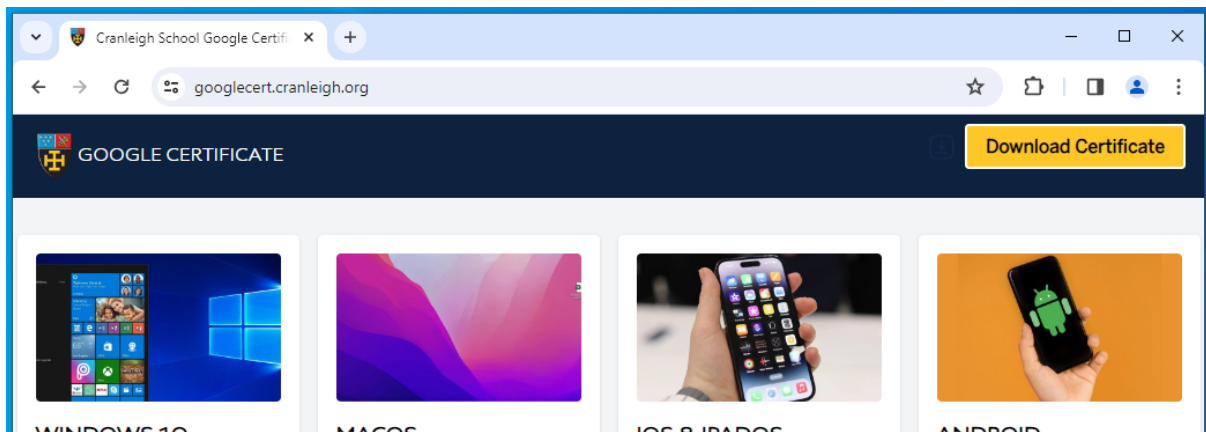

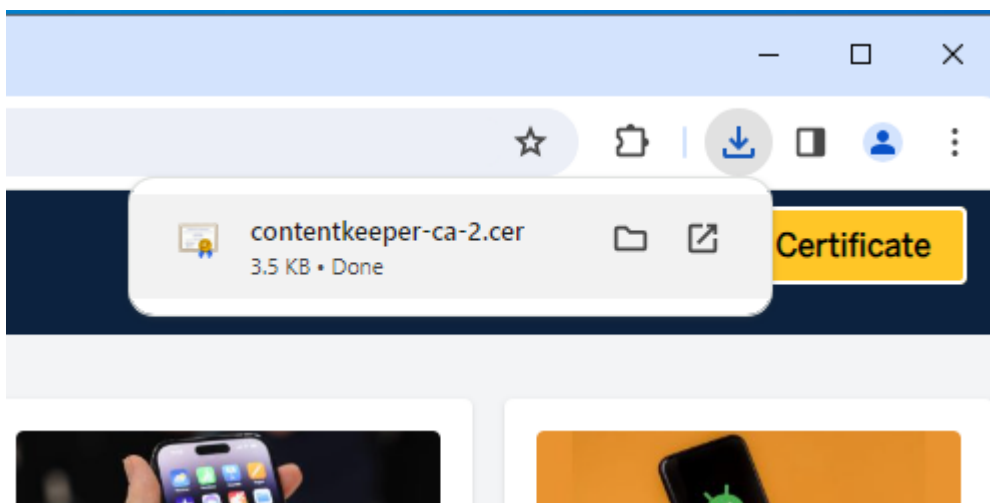
To use Google search or any of the Google apps on your device you need to download and install the Google Certificate.

These steps are **only required for personal devices** and not school owned devices.

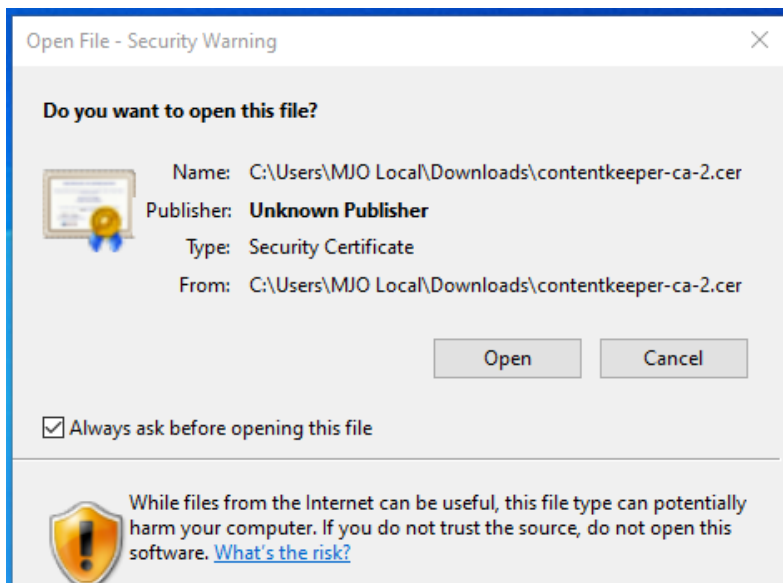
1. In Chrome, Edge or Firefox, go to <https://cert.cranleigh.org> (or scan the QR code).
2. Click the yellow “Download Certificate” button at the top of the page.



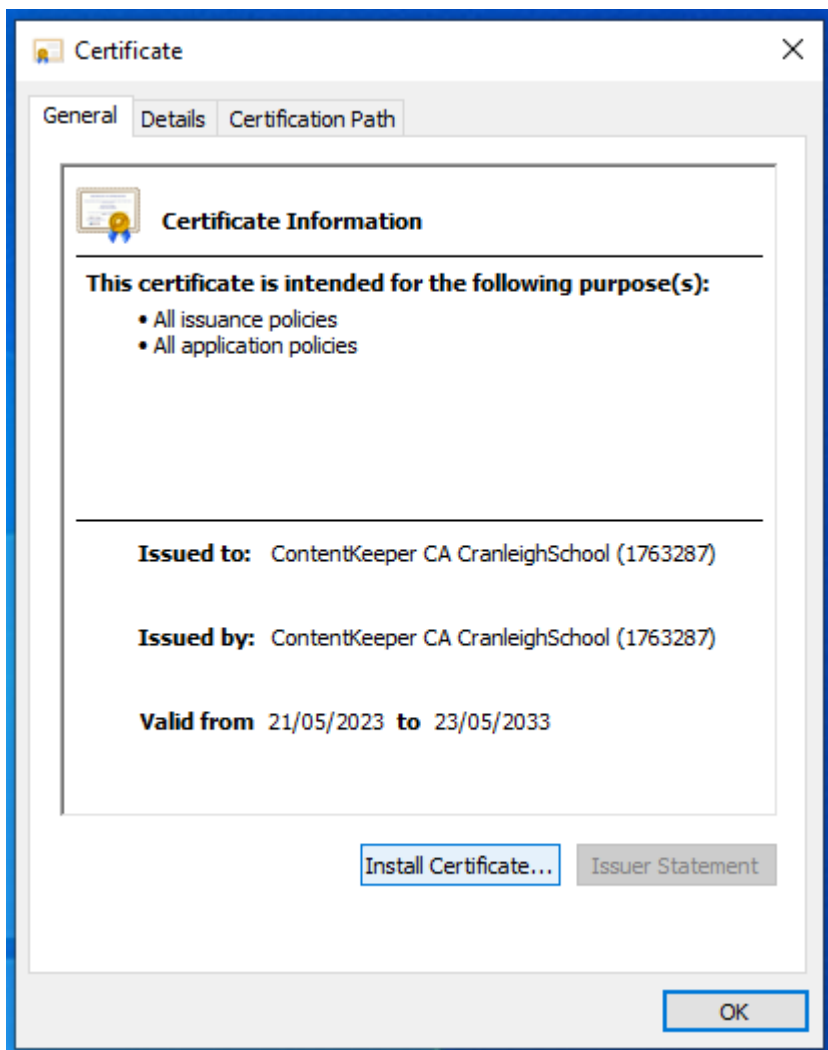
3. At the top right, Click “contentkeeper-ca-2.cer” once it has downloaded



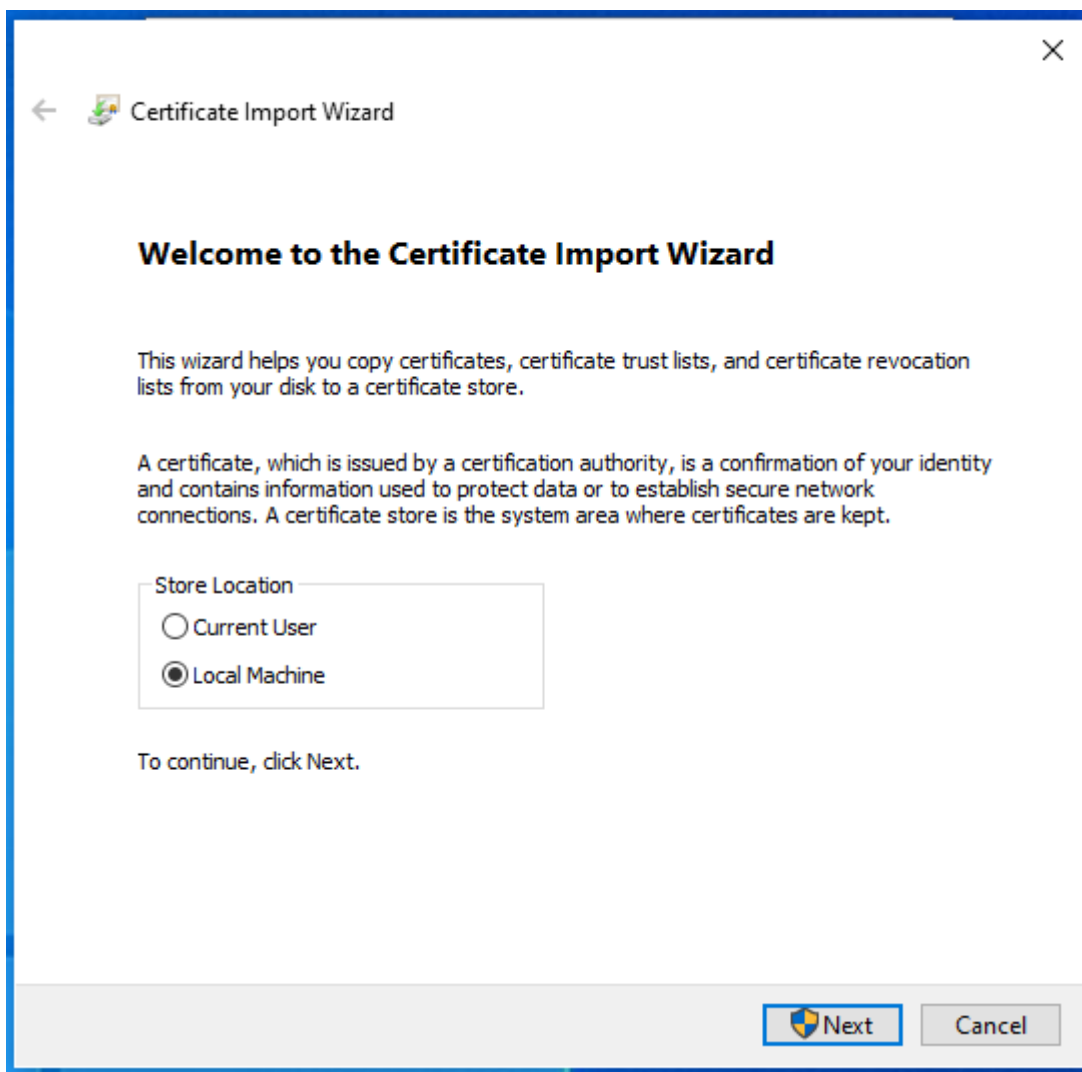
4. Click Open



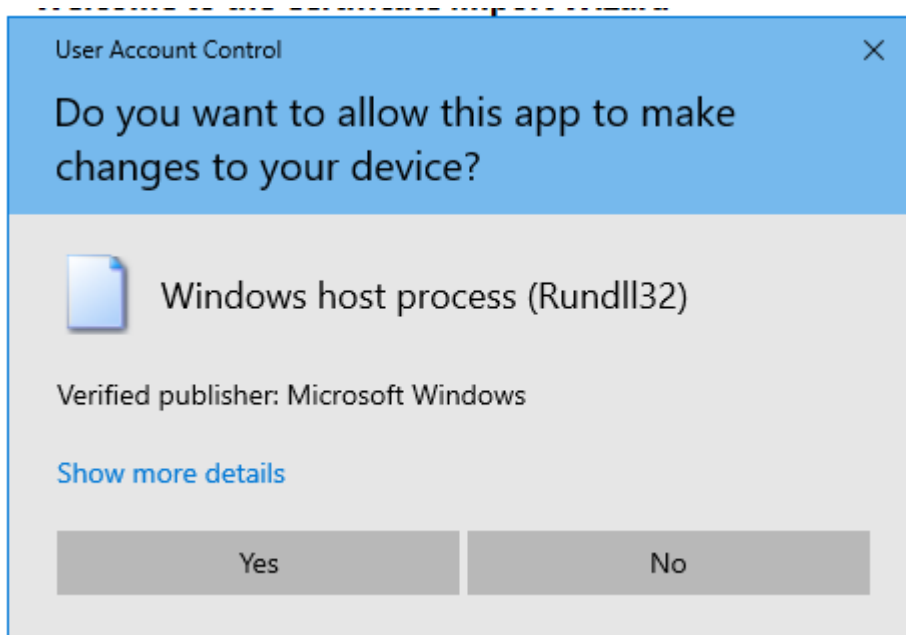
5. Then Click Install Certificate



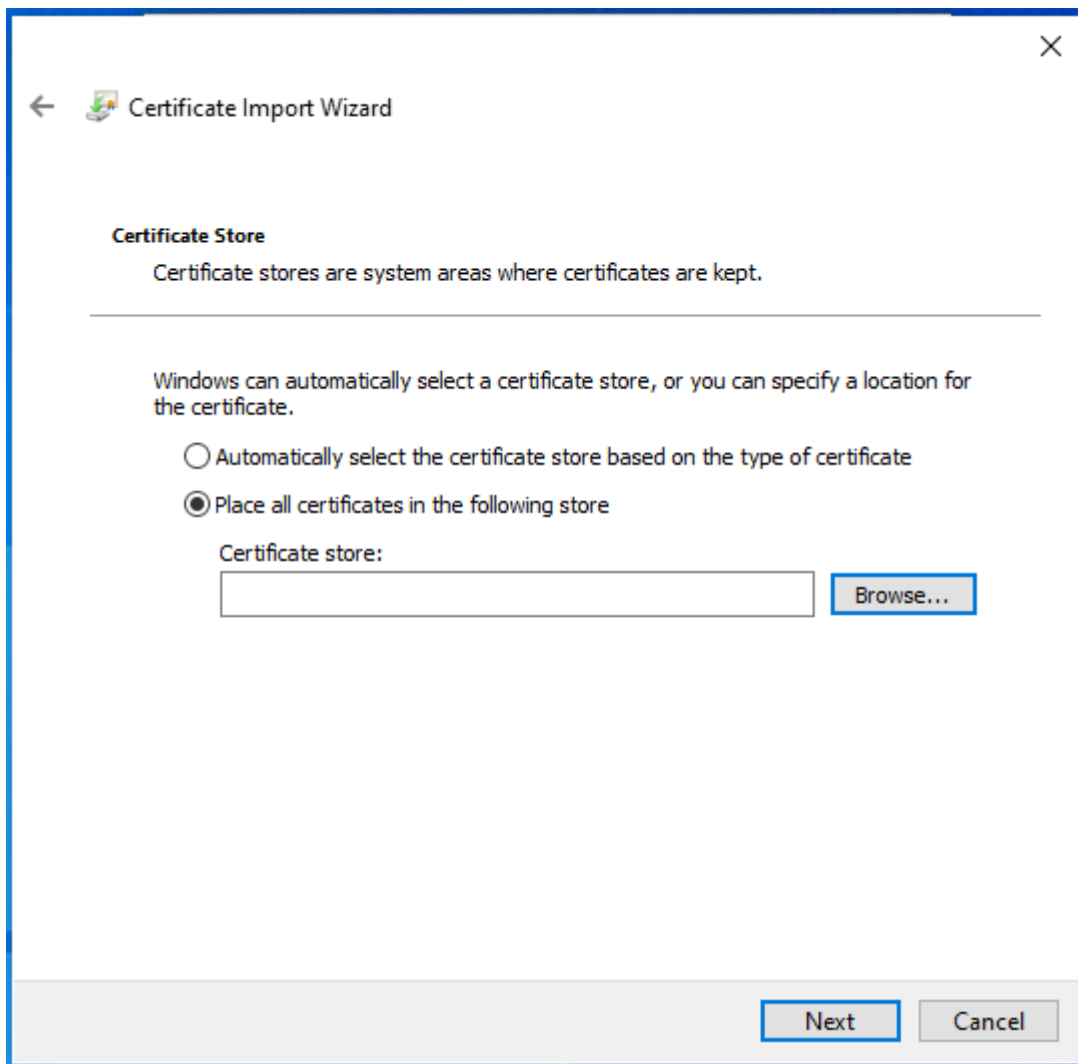
6. Select "Local Machine" and click Next



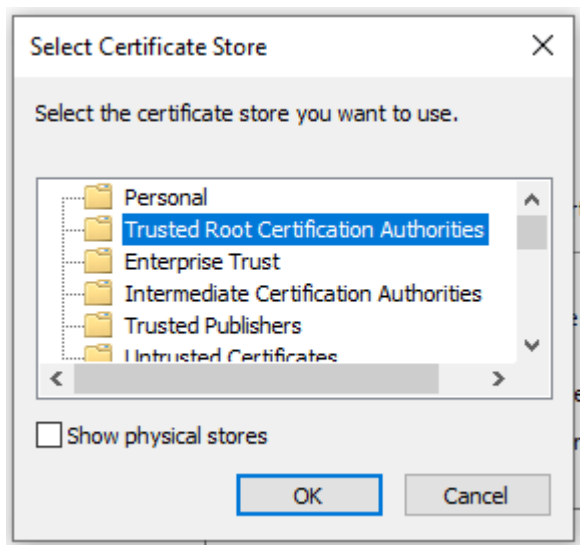
7. Click Yes, Or enter the password for your device If it asks



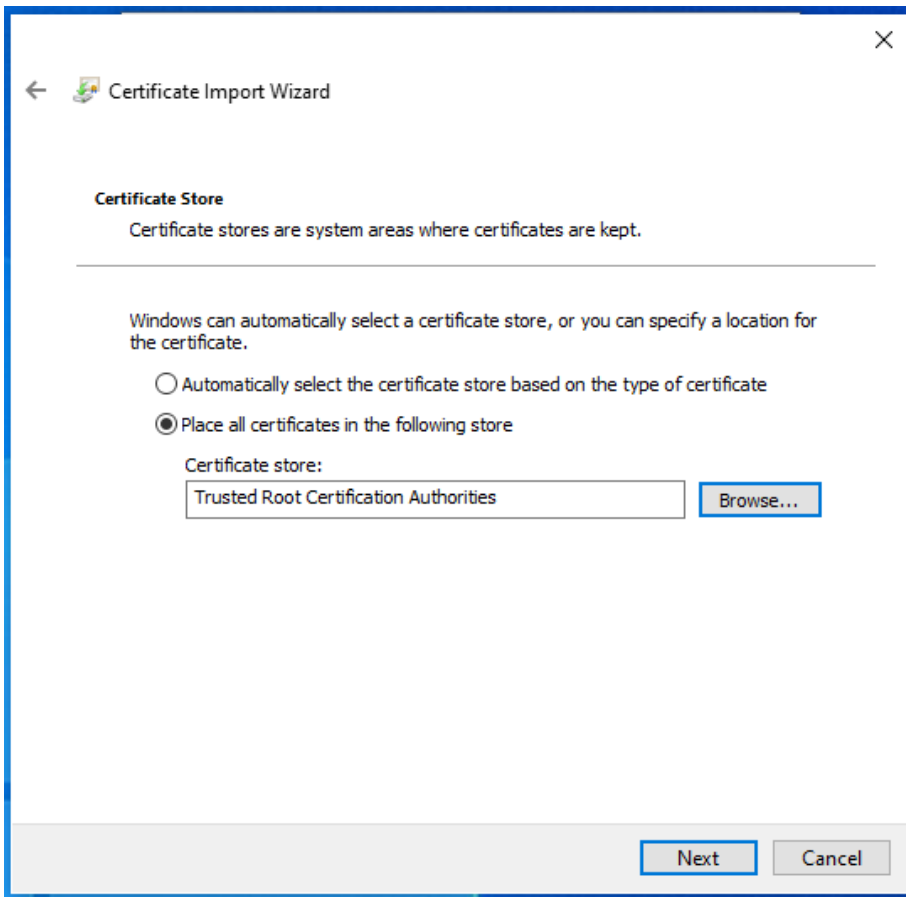
8. Click “Place all certificates in the following store” and then Browse



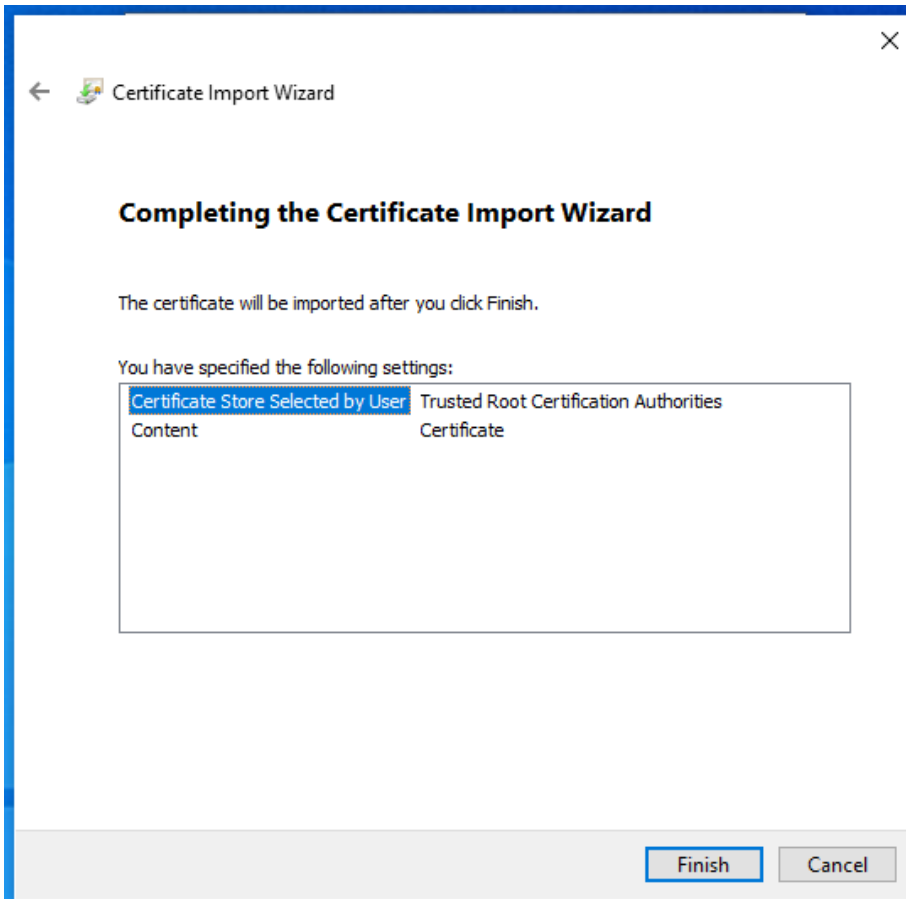
9. Select “Trusted Root Certification Authorities” and Click “OK”



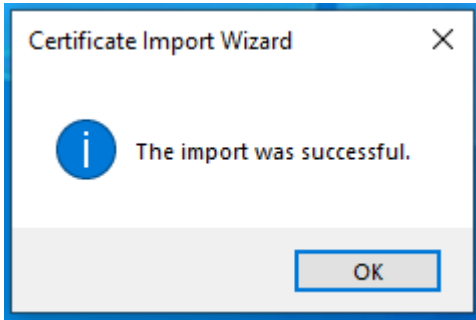
10. And then click Next



11. And Click Finish

13. You should now be done, try opening a web browser and browse to <https://www.google.com>
You should not get a Certificate Error, if you do, please close and re-open your browser or restart your device. You should now also be able to use other secure sites and applications (like Google Docs/Drive, Bing, etc)
