- 1. In Chrome, Edge or Firefox, go to https://cert.cranleigh.org (or scan the QR code).
- **2.** Click the yellow "Download Certificate" button at the top of the page.





3. At the top right, Click "contentkeeper-ca-2.cer" once it has downloaded
